



COVID Rules and Restrictions for entry to the State of Kuwait

To simply efforts to enter the State of Kuwait for the Kuwait International Rally, kindly follow the below guidelines as stated by the Kuwait Ministry of Health:

Fully Vaccinated Passenger (2 Doses of Approved Vaccine + Booster Dose)

- PCR Test is NOT required before entry to the State of Kuwait, nor required upon arrival
- No Quarantine required.
- Copy of your Vaccination Certificate stating that you have obtained 2 doses
 + booster dose of the Approved Vaccine List*
- Upload & Register your vaccination certificate on (Non-Kuwaiti Residents)

Not Fully Vaccinated Passengers**

- PCR Test is NOT required before entry to the State of Kuwait
- Home Quarantine for 7 Days upon arrival, with the option to end quarantine by conducting a PCR Test after arrival (Negative)
- Upload & Register your vaccination certificate on (Non-Kuwaiti Residents)

Unvaccinated Passengers**

- Ensure that a **NEGATIVE** PCR Test is obtained up to 72 Hours prior to arrival to the State of Kuwait
- Mandatory home quarantine for 7 Days, conducting a PCR Test on the 7th Day to end quarantine if a negative result is obtained.

*Approved Vaccines in the State of Kuwait

- o Pfizer-BioNtec (2 Doses)
- o Moderna (2 Doses)
- o AstraZeneca (2 Doses)
- o Johnson & Johnson (1 Dose)



**Not Fully Vaccinated Passengers and Unvaccinated passengers must download and register on the SHLONIK APP <u>AND</u> IMMUNE APP (IMMUNE APP must be downloaded by Fully Vaccinated Passengers aswell) available on Apple and Play Store.





- You must obtain a local SIM Card prior to leaving the airport and register via Passport Number on the Application.
- Upon arrival to the Hotel, you will be requested to conduct another PCR Test Results will be out between 6-8 Hours, until then you will be guarantined in the hotel.

Definitions

Fully Vaccinated Passengers

- Whoever received 2 doses + the booster dose of an approved COVID-19 Vaccine
- Whoever received a second dose of an approved COVID-19 Vaccine without 9 Months passing since the second dose.
- Whoever recovered from a COVID-19 Infection and has not passed 3 months since the infection date.

Not Fully Vaccinated Passengers

 Anyone who has passed the 9-month period since receiving 2 doses of an approved COVID-19 Vaccine of the anti-Coronavirus vaccine approved by the State of Kuwait is considered incomplete.

Unvaccinated Passengers

Anyone who has not received an approved COVID-19 Vaccine or has not completed the second dose is considered unvaccinated.

<u>Kindly note that other vaccines, such as Sinopharm is not accepted in the State of</u> Kuwait.

Your Vaccination certificate MUST have a valid QR Code

If you are a GCC Citizen with Sinopharm, Sinovac or Sputnik V Vaccine, you must also have one more additional dose of the above stated vaccines, otherwise you will be denied entry.
